

User's Guide

The subject and author indexes cover all issues of the Journal of Consumer Affairs, since its beginning in 1967 through 1983, and ACCI Conference Proceedings as indicated in the chronology on page iv.

Entries from the Journal give the volume number and beginning page number of the article.

Example: 17:245

Interpretation: from Volume 17 of the Journal, beginning on page 245.

Volume 11 of the Journal does not have continuous pagination throughout the two issues. These entries carry the issue number in addition to the volume number.

Example: 11(2):43

Interpretation: from Volume 11, issue 2 of the Journal, beginning on page 43.

Book reviews in the Journal are not indexed.

Entries from the ACCI Conference Proceedings are denoted with the letter "P" followed by the last two digits of the conference year and the beginning page number of the article.

Example: P75:202

Interpretation: from 1975 Proceedings, beginning on page 202.

Unless specifically needed for clarity, the use of the word "consumer" is assumed. For example, "consumer" is not used with protection, complaints, information, policy or cooperatives.
