

Michal Grinstein-Weiss, PhD, MA, MSW, is the Shanti K. Khinduka Distinguished Professor and Associate Dean for Policy Initiatives at the Brown School. She serves as director of the university-wide Social Policy Institute at Washington University and as a Nonresident Senior Fellow at the Brookings Institution. Dr. Grinstein-Weiss is an influential voice in the design of innovative social policies. She leads large-scale initiatives promoting financial inclusion and health equity through unique cross-sector partnerships. Dr. Grinstein-Weiss is pioneering the field of tax-time savings and spearheading Israel's creation of a national child savings account program. Her work also promotes evidence-based solutions for managed healthcare. Her research crosses disciplines, informing policy makers, scholars, industry leaders, and practitioners.
