

Chief, Consumer & Community Research

The Federal Reserve Board, located in Washington, DC, is seeking a Section Chief to manage the work of the Consumer & Community Research group. The Chief currently directs a group of five economists and three research assistants. The group conducts economic research to advance the Board's and public's understanding of factors affecting the financial experiences of consumers and their communities, focusing particularly on low-income and underserved populations.

The position requires a Ph.D. in economics, consumer finance, public policy, or related fields, or equivalent experience and credentials. Five years' experience managing and leading complex research projects, and publishing research on position-relevant topics in academic journals, government reports, or equivalent venues, is also required. Must have demonstrated ability to direct staff, set priorities, and manage budgets. Must also demonstrate interest in the economic well-being of low-income populations. Excellent written and oral communications skills are essential. Must demonstrate a highly refined analytical ability and the ability to oversee complex and rigorous work of others. Expertise in survey methodology and design, and prior public service experience, is preferred.
